2 KNOW WHO YOU'RE TALKING TO

- People you meet online are different from friends you know in real life.
- Be careful with messages and video chats from people you don't know.

3 FOLLOW YOUR FAMILY'S DEVICE PLAN

- Know when you can use your device and which **games, websites, and apps** are okay.
- Follow the rules your family has made for being online.

4 TALK TO A TRUSTED ADULT

- Talk to a parent, caregiver, teacher, or another trusted adult.

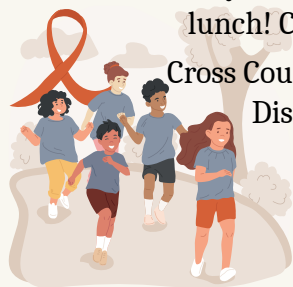
SCHOOL SPORTS

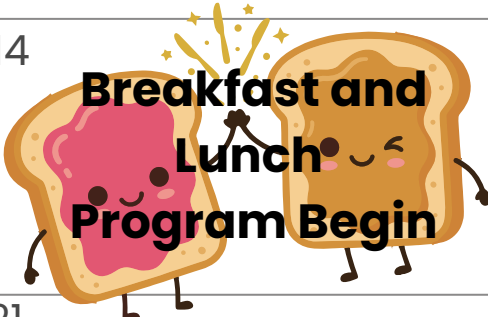
